

**BOARD OF TRUSTEES
HUSSEY-MAYFIELD MEMORIAL PUBLIC LIBRARY
PUBLIC HEARING FOR 2003 BUDGET APPEAL
September 23, 2002**

A special meeting of the Board of Trustees of the Hussey-Mayfield Memorial Public Library was held on September 23, 2002, at 6:00 p.m. Five members of the Board of Trustees were present including Tim Fisher, Lisa Hull, Bob McKnight, Matt Price and Ken Kuper. Martha Catt, Director, and Laura Hawkins, reporter for the Zionsville Times Sentinel, were also present. Tim Fisher, Vice -President, presided.

Public Hearing for 2003 Budget Appeal

Tim Fisher called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. declaring that this meeting was a hearing as noticed in the Zionsville and Lebanon newspapers for the 2003 budget appeal. The notice was published September 18, 2002 in the Zionsville Times Sentinel and the Lebanon Reporter. Tim reaffirmed that this action was taken to increase the levy and that such action was included in the resolution passed by the Board on September 16. The appeal is based on the past 3-year net assessed valuation average increase of 1.0935. The State allows public agencies to appeal if the 3-year average exceeds a positive change of at least 1.0585. At 6:15 p.m., Tim adjourned the meeting and noted that no members of the public had attended the public hearing or provided comments about the 2003 proposed budget appeal.
